The Flying Cows snapped their two game losing streak with a 111-104 victory over the Jamestown Jackals. Frederick entered halftime down 58-54 but outscored the Jackals 30-12 in the third guarter to take control of the contest.

Mustapha Traore led the way for the Flying Cows with 29 points, 10 rebounds and 5 assists. With just over a minute remaining, Traore sealed the game with an electrifying slam dunk over the outstretched arm of Jackals forward, Gentrell Taylor. Charlie Marquardt also contributed 25 points to Frederick's cause, and while Tavares Sledge had a rough 4-13 shooting performance, he still managed another double-double, scoring 12 points and grabbing 14 rebounds.

For Jamestown, David Jasson led the scoring with 28 points.

The Flying Cows now move to 12-3 and sit half a game behind the 13-3 Reading Rebels in the Atlantic Northeast division. Jamestown falls to 7-7 and takes a big hit to their playoff hopes.
