Flying Cows Once Again Show No Mercy In 52 Point Clobbering Of Tri-State

For the second consecutive game, the Frederick Flying Cows completely overwhelmed their opponent. After a 42 point victory over the Rhode Island Kraken last Sunday, the Flying Cows easily topped that with an astounding 149-97 triumph over the Tri-State Admirals.

Just like last week, the Cows seemingly put the game out of reach after only one quarter of play, ending the period with a 36-14 lead. Just like last week, it only got worse from there. The Cows scored 80 points in the second half and had at least 33 in each quarter of play.

Three players had 20 or more points for Frederick. Deon Lyle led the scoring with 24 points, and made six three pointers in seven attempts. James Edwards jr. tallied 23 points and 9 rebounds, and Charlie Marquardt finished with 21 points. The Flying Cows had 43 assists as a team, with Tevin Foster dishing out 12, and Damien Daniels having 10.

The Flying Cows shot 62.5% from the floor and outrebounded Tri-State 61 to 44.

Frederick moves to 8-1 and seems to have set up camp in first place in the Northeast division, for the time being, while Tri State falls to 2-7.
