

Flying Cows Survive Back and Forth Battle To Move To 14-3

In a game that saw eight lead changes in the final five and a half minutes, the Flying Cows prevailed 113-110 over the Jamestown Jackals. Frederick struggled offensively in the first half and found themselves trailing by 11 points at halftime, but a big third quarter, in which they held the Jackals to just 17 points, helped them get back in the game.

Mustapha Traore and Charlie Marquardt both rose to the occasion with 30+ point efforts. Traore finished with 35 points and 12 rebounds, while Marquardt had 33, including six three-pointers

For Jamestown, Derrick Colter led the scoring with 23 points.

The 14-3 Flying Cows now face another tough test in their quest to win the Atlantic Northeast division, as they will matchup against the 15-3 Reading Rebels on Friday, May 10th at 7:00pm at Hood College. Frederick and Reading have split their season series so far with Frederick defeating the Rebels in a thrilling 113-112 victory on March 2nd, and Reading getting their revenge with a comfortable 137-119 win on April 25th.
