New Look Flying Cows Cruise To Victory Over Rhode Island

The Frederick Flying Cows, sporting brand new black jerseys complete with the Flying Cow soaring over the skyline of Frederick, enjoyed a stress-free 112-67 victory over the Rhode Island Kraken.

The jerseys were not the only novelty for the Cows, as their two recent new player acquisitions immediately made an impact. Kevin Young, a former Kansas Jayhawk and NBA G-League player, finished with 13 points, 6 rebounds, 3 assists, and a few highlight-reel passes in his Flying Cows debut. Bryce Cashman, a 7'0" center, gave the Cows even more height and inside presence as he finished with 10 points and 8 rebounds.

Charlie Marquardt and Theophilus Johnson were the main scoring contributors for Frederick. Marquardt finished with 22 points and Johnson had 18. Tavares Sledge picked up his 12th double-double of the season, finishing with 14 points, 10 rebounds and 6 assists.

For Rhode Island, Rodney Simon led the scoring with 21 points.

Frederick moves to 13-3 with a road game tomorrow against the Jamestown Jackals, and a huge matchup looming on May 10th against the 14-3 Reading Rebels, in which the winner likely will gain control of first place in the Atlantic Northeast Division.
