



Flying Cows Weather Jersey Shore's Storm, Claim Victory In The End 123-101.

The Frederick Flying Cows stay hot, extending their win streak to five with a dominant performance against the Jersey Shore Breaks, final score is 123-101. Despite a slow start, the Cows flipped the switch in the second half, turning defense into offense and running away with the win.

Jersey Shore struck first, but Joe Bradshaw wasted no time answering with a three. Both squads traded high-quality offensive possessions, but the Breaks controlled the early tempo, jumping out to a 13-7 lead midway through the first. Bradshaw kept the Cows in it, crashing the boards and finishing strong in transition. Frederick closed the gap late, but still trailed 26-21 at the end of one.

Kyle Steward set the tone to open the second, bullying his way to the rim and cleaning up the glass. The Breaks, fueled by a Chris Smith three, pushed their biggest lead of the night to seven. The Cows stayed composed and weathered the storm. Quantel Denson was perfect from the field in the first half, helping Frederick snatch their first lead at 41-40 before Jersey quickly reclaimed it. Before the break, Frederick trailed by just one, 57-56.

Midway through the third, Frederick's pressure led to three straight turnovers, sparking a game changing run. By the end of the quarter, the Cows had blown it open, 92-76.

The final frame was all Cows. The offense found another gear, scoring in transition and attacking off turnovers. Jersey Shore, already shorthanded without Seth Compass and Rick Jackson, struggled to keep pace.

Frederick closed strong, never allowing the Breaks back into it. Martavian Payne continued his scoring tear, dropping 30 points, while veteran Quantel Denson locked up Michael Glover, holding him scoreless through three quarters and adding 10 points of his own. Joe Bradshaw owned the glass with 14 rebounds, while the Flying Cows flexed their muscle with six players scoring in double figures.

The Flying Cows look to keep their foot on the gas and will hit the road again for a matchup against the Capital Seahawks on Thursday, March 20th.

The Jersey Shore Breaks drop to 2-4 on the season, struggling to find consistency with key players out. Captain Chris Smith led the charge with 24 points, 7 rebounds, and 4 assists, while newly signed Desmond Jackson contributed 10 points, 5 rebounds, and 2 assists in his debut. However, free throw struggles, roster adjustments, and 19 turnovers made it tough for Jersey Shore to keep pace with the Flying Cows.
