All-Star Weekend in Frederick brings the league's best talent under one roof for a weekend of competition, community, and unforgettable highlights. The undefeated Flying Cows headline the action as they prepare to take on the top stars from across the TBL.

# **3v3 Championship Tournament**

All-Star Weekend in Frederick delivered high-level energy with a competitive 3v3 round-robin tournament where each team battled for the best overall record. The Flying Cows opened strong with a gritty 9-6 win over Team Frederick, sparked by Bobby Connors hustle and a clutch jumper from Nebbie.

However, they fell short in Game 3 against the Virginia Valley Vipers, who lit it up from beyond the arc. The championship matchup featured the Vipers and the New York All-Stars, where New York's sharp shooting and rebounding, led by Shadell Millinghaus, secured them the title.

#### 3 Point Contest presented by Roy Rogers

Flying Cows shooters made their presence felt during the 3-point contest. Richard Rivers knocked down 11 threes, while Tavares Sledge impressed with 14 points, keeping the Cows in the mix.

The overall competition was fierce, with Trashon Burnell of the Albany Patroons catching fire early and finishing with 18 points to win it all. Anthony Whitley and Shadell Mingus also put up strong performances with 17 each, but Burnell sealed the crown in Round 2 with another 18-point showing.

#### Slam Dunk Contest presented by Visit Frederick

The Flying Cows dominated the dunk contest with high-flying performances that electrified the crowd. Dylan Haugen stole the show, throwing down a perfect-score dunk, leaping over Bobby Connors and going through the legs for a 50. At just 17 years old, the high school phenom and professional dunker Dylan Haugen soared past the competition to win the All-Star Weekend Dunk Contest, earning a coveted spot in the TBL All-Star Weekend showdown.

Ed Dyson followed with a powerful 360 two-hand slam for a 42, then nearly matched Heughan in Round 2 with a self-thrown alley-oop one-hand tomahawk that scored a 49.

Dylan kept the momentum, tossing it to himself again and hammering an impressive tomahawk. In the championship round, Huegan sealed his win with an unreal dunk over Flying Cows Captain Tavares Sledge, finishing behind the back mid-air and bringing the house down. Ed Dyson added a final dunk for 25, but the crown clearly belonged to Dylan after a perfect 50.
