

## Flying Cows Flawless Ahead of All-Star Break 113-85 Over the Seahawks

The Flying Cows closed out the weekend and the first half of their season in style, overpowering the Capital Seahawks 113-85 in a heated rematch at home. The win improves the Cows to a perfect 13-0 on the year, capping off a strong back-to-back stretch and sending them into the All-Star break as one of the TBL's league's top teams.

This matchup had a bit of extra juice, Game 3 of the weekend slate, and a rematch with a feisty Seahawks squad led by All-Star guard Andre Fox. The last time these two teams met, the Flying Cows edged out a gritty Game 1 and controlled Game 2.

Capital came out sharp, forcing early turnovers and taking an early lead while the Cows struggled to find rhythm offensively. The visiting Seahawks brought plenty of fans with them, and their energy was felt in a tightly contested first period. The Seahawks did their homework, they were well-prepared and seemingly predicting the Flying Cows offense. Their early reads and defensive adjustments disrupted the Cows usual rhythm out of the gate.

After some adjustments from Coach Ed Corporal the Cows crafted a highlight reel of picture worthy dunks, setting the tone physically, even as the scoreboard remained tight. Emotions ran high, and the tension boiled over when Seahawks forward Marcus Kennedy was ejected after pushing Coach Ed Corporal. Heated matchup or not, there's no room for that in this league. By the end of 1st, the Flying Cows moved ahead 29-23.

The second quarter began with a burst from the Seahawks, who briefly stretched their lead behind tough buckets from Bruce Massey Jr., who fought valiantly to keep his team in the fight. Massey ended his day with 18 points and 8 rebounds. But, once the Cows found their rhythm, they hit the gas and never looked back.

Joe Bradshaw was instrumental in the first half, scoring 14 points and doing all the dirty work in the paint. He set the tone with second-chance buckets, and his patented relentless hustle. Joe Bradshaw lit up the scoreboard with 24 points, and grabbed 17 rebounds, and 2 assists. One of his best performances of his young TBL career.

Fueled by their defense, the Cows pushed forward with a commanding 19-point lead. The Seahawks looked stunned as the momentum shifted dramatically. At the Halftime break, The Flying Cows lead, 59-40.

In the second half, veteran and winningest head coach Ed Corporal made a key adjustment by shifting to a zone defense, a strategic decision that showcased his experience.

With a full team effort on both ends of the floor, the Flying Cows maintained a comfortable 20-point cushion throughout the third. Tavares Sledge, back in the lineup after missing two games, brought a veteran presence and physicality that elevated the squad. He was able to score 12 points, 8 rebounds, and 6 assists.

Andre Fox tried to keep his squad within striking distance, but the Cows defense keyed in, closing off driving lanes and forcing tough shots. The 2025 All-star was held to 14 points and 1 assist. By the fourth quarter, the Flying Cows lead was extended to 101-73 and the loud Seahawks fans began heading for the exits.

Damien Daniel's continued his steady floor leadership, getting 13 points and 6 assists. while Javon Adams added another efficient 23-point performance, making it nine straight games in double figures. He also added 14 rebounds and 2 assists to his stat line. Captain Tavares Sledge was back and got to the line repeatedly, weaving through traffic and making great efforts, closing with 12 points, 8 rebounds, and 6 assists.

As the game closed out, there were no more Seahawks fans to speak of, Final Score: Flying Cows 113 - Seahawks 85. The Capital Seahawks drop another tough one and fall to 10-4. All-Star guard Andre Fox will be Back in Frederick next week for an exciting All-star weekend.

While the Flying Cows ride into the All-Star break undefeated and battle-tested. With momentum high, healthy players returning, and contributions coming from every part of the roster, the Cows look like a team on a mission.

After this weekend, the Cows will host the TBL All-Star Weekend in Frederick, MD, taking place at Woodsboro Bank Arena at Hood College on April 18th and 19th. The action kicks off Friday at 7 p.m. with All-Star Friday Night festivities, followed by a free Jr. TBL Youth Basketball Clinic on Saturday morning at 9 a.m. Then on Saturday night (April 19th) at 7 p.m., the Cows take the court against the TBL All-Star Team in what's set to be an exciting showdown.
