He finished the game with a well-rounded stat line of 11 points, 8 rebounds and 8 assists, keeping the offense flowing.

Energy off the bench came in the form of Ed Dyson, who ignited the crowd with a multitude of highlight plays. Dyson ended the night with 10 points and 9 assists, providing a spark for Frederick. By the end of third the score was 95 - 56 in favor of the Cows.

Joe Bradshaw lit it up from the field, shooting an impressive 70%, showcasing his great shot selection. He also crashed the boards effectively, finishing with 16 points and 12 rebounds.
