Flying Cows Set Sights on TBL Title, TBL Playoffs Begin Tonight, Cows Host Game 2 This Saturday.

The Frederick Flying Cows will officially begin their 2025 The Basketball League (TBL) Playoff campaign and enter the postseason ranked #1 in the Eastern Conference. After a dominant 21-3 regular season, the Flying Cows now face a much tougher slate of competition as they aim for their first TBL championship title. With fan bases stretching coast to coast. Including teams from California to Florida to New York and even Canada, this year's TBL Playoffs are bigger than ever and promise nationwide interest in Frederick's only professional basketball team.

The TBL Playoffs began this week and feature 16 total teams (8 from the East, 8 from the West), competing across four high-stakes rounds: Divisional, Regional, Conference, and Championship. Each round follows a best-of-three format, with one round played per week. Lose two games in a series and the season is over.

Game 1 will take place on Thursday, May 29th at 7 PM on the road against the Reading Rebels. Fans can gather to cheer on the team at the official watch party hosted at Frederick Social, with doors opening at 6:30 PM. The Flying Cows return home for Game 2 on Saturday, May 31st at 7 PM at Hood College. If necessary, a Game 3 will be held on Sunday, June 1st at 5 PM, also at Hood College.

The first 150 fans through the doors Saturday night will receive a free "Championship Chase" T-shirt. Early arrival is strongly recommended to claim yours.

Before each home playoff game, fans are invited to take part in a one-of-a-kind local tradition: meet at Charm City Run and jog together to Hood College, led by team mascot Milkshake.

If the Flying Cows advance to the Regional Round, they are guaranteed to remain the higher seed and will face either the Raleigh Firebirds or the Tampa Bay Titans. The tentative schedule for the Regional Round includes Game 1 on Thursday, June 5th (away), followed by Game 2 on Sunday, June 8th at 5 PM at Hood College. If necessary, Game 3 will be played on Monday, June 9th at 7 PM, also at Hood College.

Members of the press are invited to attend and cover the Frederick Flying Cows playoff games. This is a unique opportunity to document one of the top teams in The Basketball League as they compete in a national postseason tournament that continues to grow.
