Baltimore Pulls Away Late to Defeat Flying Cows, 88–77

Scott and Adams lead Frederick's late push, but Rhythm holds on down the stretch.

The Frederick Flying Cows returned to Woodsboro Bank Arena looking to build momentum in their second game of the season, hosting the Baltimore Rhythm in front of an energetic home crowd. Despite several highlight plays and strong individual performances, Baltimore pulled away late in the fourth quarter to secure an 88–77 victory over Frederick.

Baltimore controlled the opening tip and struck first, while the Flying Cows struggled to find their rhythm early in the first quarter. Frederick eventually settled in when they connected on their first field goal with just over nine minutes remaining. A powerful dunk at the 8:29 mark energized the crowd and helped spark the Cows' offense. By the time the first timeout arrived with 6:28 remaining, Frederick held a narrow 10–8 lead. Later in the quarter, Zyon Smith knocked down a clutch three-pointer to give the Cows a 15–14 advantage before adding another score moments later. Strong contributions from Smith and Javon Adams helped keep the game tight, but Baltimore edged ahead late, taking a slim 23–22 lead at the end of the first quarter.

The second quarter began slowly for Frederick once again, but Mustapha Traore opened the scoring for the Cows after several scoreless minutes. A three-pointer from Ronald Scott tied the game at 27–27 with seven minutes remaining in the half. Quentin Scott then stepped to the line after drawing a transition foul and calmly knocked down both free throws to keep Frederick within striking distance. Adams added a key three-pointer to push his point total to nine, while Traore later finished a transition layup that tied the contest at 36–36. Smith added his second three-pointer of the game before halftime, as the Cows relied on balanced scoring from Smith, Traore, and Adams. Despite their efforts, Baltimore entered the locker room with a 52–43 lead at the break.

Frederick came out aggressively in the third quarter. Ronald Scott immediately knocked down a three-pointer to cut into the deficit before adding another basket moments later, bringing his total to 10 points. Zach Thomas provided a boost with an offensive putback that trimmed the Baltimore lead further. The biggest moment of the quarter came when Quentin Scott delivered a thunderous poster dunk that electrified the arena. Shortly after, Scott recorded a big defensive block that led to a fast-break three-pointer from Thomas. Scott continued to carry the momentum for Frederick, hitting a mid-range jumper and later a three-pointer that cut the deficit to just three points with under two minutes remaining in the quarter. Denmark Slay added his first points of the game with a three-pointer, helping the Cows stay close. By the end of the third quarter, Frederick had trimmed the deficit to 70–66.

The Flying Cows continued battling in the fourth quarter. With 6:16 remaining, Thomas knocked down a three-pointer for Frederick's first basket of the period. Quentin Scott delivered his second dunk of the night and took over the team scoring lead with 16 points. On the defensive end, Mekhi Grant provided a key block that sparked a fast break opportunity, which Adams finished with a transition dunk to keep the Cows within reach.

Despite Frederick's effort and several momentum-shifting plays, Baltimore maintained control in the final minutes and closed out the game with an 88–77 victory.

Quentin Scott and Javon Adams led the Flying Cows offensively, providing energy on both ends of the floor throughout the contest. Frederick also received key contributions from Zyon Smith, Mustapha Traore, Ronald Scott, and Zach Thomas, who each delivered timely baskets to keep the game competitive.

The Flying Cows will look to regroup and bounce back as they continue their season, aiming to build on the strong moments and highlight plays shown throughout the matchup.
