**Frederick Flying Cows Powers Past Reading Rebels, Extends Winning Streak to Three Games**

The Frederick Flying Cows returned home to Woodsboro Bank Arena on Saturday night to take on the 4-10 Reading Rebels. Entering the matchup looking to build momentum, Frederick delivered a strong four-quarter performance to secure a hard-fought 116-112 victory.

Reading opened the game by winning the tip, but it didn't take long for Frederick to respond, as Mekhi Grant got the Cows on the board first. D'Andre Johnson knocked down a three with nine minutes to go in the quarter, followed by a Shadell Millinghaus and-one to keep the offense rolling. Zyon Smith and Ronald Scott then hit back-to-back three-pointers to energize the home crowd. Damien Daniels also made his return felt early, knocking down a free throw for his first points back with the team. Despite the strong stretches, Reading closed the quarter ahead, 32-26.

The Cows quickly flipped the momentum in the second quarter. Johnson opened the frame with another three-pointer, and Millinghaus followed with one of his own to cut the deficit to two. A Ronald Scott layup soon after gave Frederick its first lead since the early moments of the first quarter. From there, both teams traded baskets in a competitive back-and-forth stretch, but Frederick carried a 58-54 lead into halftime.

Frederick came out of the break with energy, as Johnson once again opened the quarter with a three. Grant threw down a dunk early in the period, and Johnson followed with one of his own to keep the pressure on Reading. The Rebels responded with a push of their own, briefly reclaiming the lead at 68-67. Zyon Smith answered with an electric dunk, followed by an Alani Moore three-pointer to swing momentum back in Frederick's favor. Millinghaus added a tough, contested 180 layup late in the quarter, helping the Cows take an 84-79 lead into the fourth.

In the final quarter, Frederick continued to deliver in key moments. Damien Daniels opened the scoring with a jab-step three, while Millinghaus added an and-one layup with nine minutes remaining. Quentin Scott then provided a crucial spark, knocking down a three-pointer and converting an and-one on back-to-back possessions. As the game tightened late, Millinghaus attacked the rim for an important layup, and Scott calmly converted free throws down the stretch to seal the win.

Frederick closed out the contest with a 116-112 victory, securing another strong performance in front of the home crowd.

Ronald Scott led the way for the Flying Cows with 21 points and 9 rebounds. Quentin Scott matched him with 21 points while adding 3 rebounds, and Shadell Millinghaus filled the stat sheet with 19 points, 6 assists, 4 rebounds, and 2 steals.

For Reading, Mi'Quan Tucker led all scorers with 27 points while adding 3 rebounds.

Overall, Reading controlled the glass, outrebounding Frederick 57-46, but the Cows' timely shot-making and balanced scoring proved to be the difference.

With the win, Frederick improves to 7-8 on the season and extends its winning streak to three games. The Flying Cows will have a quick turnaround, hitting the road tomorrow to face the undefeated 15-0 Capital Seahawks.

Frederick will return home to Woodsboro Bank Arena on Friday, May 8th at 7 PM to take on the 9-7 Virginia Valley Vipers, as they look to keep their momentum rolling in front of the home crowd.
