Flying Cows' Playoff Run Ends in Hard-Fought Semifinal Battle Against Capital

Frederick rallies multiple times but falls 105-101 to the Seahawks in the 94x50 League Semifinals.

The Frederick Flying Cows saw their 2026 season come to an end Saturday afternoon, falling 105-101 to the Capital Seahawks in the semifinals of the 94x50 League Playoffs at AC Jordan Arena.

Facing a Capital squad that entered the game with a 23-1 record, the Flying Cows battled throughout all four quarters and erased multiple deficits before ultimately coming up just short against the league's top seed.

Quentin Scott got Frederick on the board with a jump shot to open the game and later converted an and-one opportunity as the Flying Cows looked to match Capital's early energy. The Seahawks found their rhythm late in the quarter, however, closing the period on a run to take a 30-21 advantage after one.

Frederick responded in the second quarter behind timely perimeter shooting. Ronald Scott opened the frame with a three-pointer before Zach Thomas followed with one of his own. Shadell Millinghaus then caught fire offensively, leading a surge that included back-to-back three-pointers as the Flying Cows chipped away at the deficit. Despite the strong response, Capital carried a 55-47 lead into halftime.

The Flying Cows continued their comeback effort immediately after the break. Millinghaus opened the third quarter with a layup before Ronald Scott and Millinghaus connected on consecutive three-pointers to tie the game at 59. Thomas added two more triples to give Frederick a 69-67 lead, and Damien Daniels knocked down a three-pointer of his own as the teams traded momentum throughout the period.

Although Frederick briefly grabbed the advantage, Capital answered and entered the fourth quarter holding a narrow 82-80 lead.

The Seahawks opened the final quarter with another run, stretching the lead back to double digits. Frederick refused to go away. Ronald Scott connected from beyond the arc to keep the Flying Cows within striking distance, and Daniels delivered a clutch late jumper that nearly brought the game within a single possession. Upon review, however, his foot was ruled on the line, making it a two-point basket instead of a three.

The Flying Cows continued to battle until the final horn, but Capital made enough plays down the stretch to hold off Frederick's comeback attempt and secure a 105-101 victory.

Millinghaus led the Flying Cows with a standout all-around performance, finishing with 27 points, 7 rebounds, 4 steals, and 3 blocks. Quentin Scott added 20 points and 7 rebounds, while Zach Thomas contributed 21 points and 2 steals. Ronald Scott filled the stat sheet with 19 points, 7 assists, and 5 rebounds in the loss.

Capital was led by Andre Fox, who recorded 17 points and 12 rebounds to help send the Seahawks to the league championship game.

While the season ended one win short of the finals, the Flying Cows closed the year by winning three of their final four games and advancing to the 94x50 League Semifinals. After overcoming injuries, roster changes, and a challenging regular season, Frederick's postseason run showcased the resilience that defined the team throughout the 2026 campaign.
