### **Flying Cows Drop Regular Season Finale at New York Phoenix Ronald Scott Posts Triple-Double; Cows Host Round 1 of the Playoffs Thursday**

The Frederick Flying Cows closed out the regular season Friday night on the road against the New York Phoenix at M&T Bank Center, falling 128-106 to one of the top teams in the 94x50 league. Despite a triple-double from Ronald Scott and a balanced scoring effort, the Cows could not overcome a 60-percent shooting night from the Phoenix and a 21-rebound deficit on the glass.

New York came out swinging in the opening quarter, jumping out to an early lead behind quick ball movement and efficient interior scoring. The Cows kept pace early thanks to steady production from Ronald Scott and Damien Daniels, but the Phoenix took a 33-26 lead into the second.

Frederick flipped the script in the second quarter, outscoring New York 30-28 thanks to a balanced offensive attack. Damien Daniels and Quentin Scott both attacked the paint with purpose, while Zyon Smith and Garrison Linton added timely buckets off the perimeter. The Cows trimmed the deficit and trailed 61-56 at halftime.

New York re-established control in the third quarter, leaning on its size and shot-making to push the lead back out. Frederick continued to grind, with Ronald Scott orchestrating the offense and Damien Daniels finding teammates in transition, but the Phoenix took a 90-80 lead into the fourth.

The final quarter belonged to New York. The Phoenix poured in 38 points behind a balanced bench effort, with Tyshon Pickett, AJ Mosby, and Wali Hepburn all making winning plays down the stretch. Frederick refused to fold, with Ronald Scott continuing to fill the stat sheet and Damien Daniels providing late-game energy, but the deficit proved too steep to overcome. New York closed out the contest with a 128-106 victory.

Ronald Scott led the way for Frederick with a triple-double — 29 points, 10 rebounds, and 11 assists — turning in one of the most complete individual performances of his season. Damien Daniels followed with 22 points on 8-of-16 shooting, adding 6 rebounds, 8 assists, and a

team-high 5 steals. Quentin Scott contributed 19 points and 7 rebounds, while Zyon Smith chipped in 15 points, 3 assists, and 4 steals. Garrison Linton added 11 points off the bench.

For New York, six players finished in double figures. Reserve guard Tyshon Pickett led all scorers with 19 points on 9-of-14 shooting, while Qadir Welton turned in a double-double with 16 points and a game-high 14 rebounds. Denzel Banks and AJ Mosby added 16 points apiece, and reserve guard Wali Hepburn handed out 10 assists in another balanced effort for the Phoenix.

New York controlled the contest on the glass, out-rebounding Frederick 61-40, and shot a blistering 60.0% from the field and 45.5% from beyond the arc. The Cows forced 20 Phoenix turnovers and posted 12 steals, but struggled from the perimeter, finishing 11-of-49 (22.4%) from three-point range.

With the loss, Frederick closes the regular season at 11-13. The Flying Cows now turn their full attention to the postseason, hosting Round 1 of the 94x50 Playoffs on Thursday, June 11th at 7PM at Woodsboro Bank Arena. The official 94x50 playoff bracket — and Frederick's Round 1 opponent — will be announced Sunday, June 7th. Tickets for the playoff matchup are on sale now at [goflyingcows.com](http://goflyingcows.com), and The Barn is expected to be packed.
